



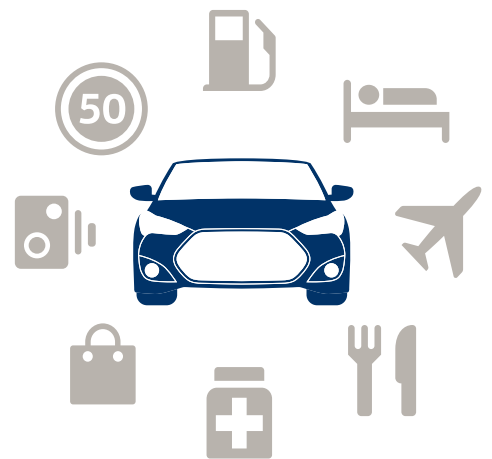

State	Map description key road changes
Australian Capital Territory	Harrison Dual Carriageway: A section of road has been updated in terms of becoming a dual carriageway between Mapleton Ave and Well Station Rd in Harrison.
	Cotter Road: A section of road has been updated to a dual carriageway between Mcculloh St and Tuggeranong Pkwy
Western Australia	Mitchell Freeway: A section of 6kms of dual carriage has been added as well as three new interchanges, the extension of Neerabup Rd and the widening of Wanneroo Rd and Hester Ave. This new freeway will improve transport efficiency in Perth's far north suburbs, promote traffic flow and ease congestion in local areas
New South Wales	Foxground Bypass: The new bypass has been added at Foxground from Toolijooa Rd to Wood hill Mountain Rd
	Pacific Highway: A section of road has been updated to a dual carriageway between Kempsey and Kundabung
	Pacific Highway: The Berry Bypass has been added in Berry, NSW
	Pacific Highway: A new section of road has been added between Corindini to Dirty Creek
	Sydney Harbour Bridge: The exit ramps approaching the city have been updated for Grosvenor St and York St
	Sydney International Airport: The new northbound road has been added
	Newel Highway: The bypass at Grong Grong has been added
Victoria	Tullamarine Freeway: A new southbound ramp has been extended to join the ramp exit between Bell st and the Tullamarine Fwy
	Merinda Park Boulevard: A new section of road has been added between Thompsons Rd and Cranbourne North to allow access to Merinda Park Train station
	Princes Highway: A section of road has been updated to a dual carriageway between Sale-Cowwarr Rd and Sale-Heyfield Rd in Fulham.
Queensland	Mount Lindsay Highway: The Beaudesert Town Centre Bypass has been added
South Australia	South Road: A section of road has been added between Port Rd and Henry St, Croydon
